I am requesting funding for the Montesano Fire Station Modernization and Public Safety Expansion project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Montesano, located at 112 N. Main St, Montesano, WA 98563.

The funding would be used to modernize the City of Montesano's 1979 fire station and to strengthen regional emergency response.
