The funding would be used to construct a roundabout on US Highway 101 at the Hoh Highlands intersection. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would provide a significant traffic safety measure to reduce vehicle speed and improve the safety of all motorists at this developing residential and community access point for the Hoh Indian Tribe and nearby communities.
