- Coordinates closely with the District Director and D.C. staff to ensure district priorities are reflected in the Member's legislative priorities



- Informs the District Director and the Member on up-and-coming issues in the district

- Able to make split-second decisions and develop events and public-facing engagements under tight deadlines
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Time management skills, ability to work under pressure, and comfortable balancing multiple responsibilities at once
