I am requesting funding for the Queets Wastewater Treatment Plant project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Quinault Indian Nation, located at 1214 Aalis Dr, Taholah, WA 98587.

The funding would be used for a multi-celled treatment system for the Queets wastewater treatment plant. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the existing wastewater treatment plant, situated within the floodplain and the tsunami inundation zone, has surpassed its expected lifespan and needs to be replaced and relocated.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1383(c) (Section 603(c) of the Clean Water Act).
